#### **What is it?**

National Youth Leadership / Twin Arrows (NYLT/TA) Training is the premier youth leadership development course for the Boy Scouts of America within the Longhorn Council. It brings together youth leaders from all over the council to learn and apply the skills they need to be effective leaders in their teams and units. This course draws upon the most current leadership models used by corporate America, academic circles, and successful outdoor leadership organizations throughout the country. This exciting and fast-paced training discusses team development and appropriate leadership strategies to enable teams and units to reach their highest performance level. #### **Participants requirements** (updated March 2013)

##### **If you are attending as a Boy Scout, you must:**

- Be a registered member of a Scout Troop for a period of 6 months prior to the start of the course.
- Have earned your 1st Class Rank by the start of the course,
- Be 13 years of age by the first day of the course and have not yet reached your 18th birthday by the last day of the course.
- Have your Scoutmaster's and Parent/Guardian's approval.
- Be capable of functioning safely and being self-reliant in an outdoor environment.
- Have completed ILST (Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops)
- Have parts A and B of the BSA Medical Form submitted with your application, and have part C submitted to the Course Director no less than 72 hours prior to the start of the course.

#### **When is it?**

There are five 6 day courses per year in March, July and December, all coincide with school breaks. Look at the link above to see specific dates and locations.

#### **Troop 28 Scholarship Program**

The program costs \$200 to attend and the Troop will reimburse half the tuition with additional financial consideration available. All the Troop asks for in return is that you serve in a leadership position in the Troop within the next year after completing the program.

#### **Staff Positions Available**

If you are a Scout that has already taken Twin Arrows or are an interested adult, there are positions available to staff the sessions. This cost is \$125 and will be fully reimbursed by the Troop. This is a great opportunity for adults to and Scouts to fine tune their skills.
